Elliott, Stewart: Born: March 1, 1965. From: Toronto, Canada.

Father was a jockey. Won the Kentucky Derby and Preakness Stakes in 2004 on Smarty Jones then finished 2nd in the third leg, the Belmont Stakes.

Experienced some career highs and lows for the subsequent 12 years. In 2014 he got kicked by a horse and broke his ribs, came back to riding too early and subsequently missed almost a year of riding. In the Spring of 2016 he shifted his tack to Southern California and fairly immediately started riding some for Bob Baffert. This was at roughly the same time that Baffert and Garcia had a falling out.

Elliott has found some success in California and, in the Fall of 2016 won the leading rider title at Los Alamitos. Won his first graded stakes race since 2014 on Gloryzapper when they teamed to win the G3 L.A. Woman Stakes at Santa Anita in October 2016. Finished 2016 with 62 wins from 494 races. In 2017 his 582 mounts yielded 66 trips to the winner's circle.

Has won nearly 4,800 races including the Kentucky Derby and the Preakness stakes but has yet to hit the board in the Breeders' Cup.
