

Prado, Edgar (HOF 2008): Born: June 12, 1967. From: Lima, Peru.

Originally from Peru but his big break came in 1997 when he won 536 races, making him the fourth rider in history to win 500 races in one year. Much of that success was gained in Maryland, where he ruled that circuit for several years. He now calls Florida home and in 2004 Prado became the 19th jockey in thoroughbred racing history to win 5,000 races.

Has won three of the Triple Crown races: Belmont Stakes: 2002 (Sarava), 2004 (Birdstone). Kentucky Derby: 2006 (Barbaro). Owns 4 Breeders' Cup wins: two in 2005, 2006 and 2015.

Inducted into the National Museum of Racing **Hall of Fame in 2008.**

Family: Wife, Liliana. They have three children: Edgar Jr, Louis and Patricia.
