

Boudot, Pierre-Charles: Born: Dec. 21, 1992 From: Paray-le-Monial, France.

Use both first names, as in “Pierre-Charles”. Boudot, son of the late trainer Marc Boudot, won his first race in 2009 and has gradually become a successful jockey in Europe. In 2019 won his first Prix de l’Arc de Triomphe then in 2020 won his first Breeders’ Cup race(s) on Audarya in the Filly & Mare Turf (when originally named rider Ioritz Mendizabal had to give up the mount after testing positive for COVID-19). Two races later, he substituted for rider Christophe Soumillon on longshot Order of Australia in the Mile after Boudot's original mount One Master scratched and Soumillon was unable to ride, also due to a COVID-19 positive. The also-eligible rallied late to upset the Mile and add to an incredible, unexpected Breeders' Cup haul for the French rider.
